

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

SAMARKAND STATE UNIVERSITY, UZBEKISTAN

AND

DEPARTMENT OF EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION

DONGGUK UNIVERSITY, GYEONGJU, REPUBLIC OF KOREA

Samarkand State University and Department of Early Childhood Education at Dongguk University, Gyeongju are linked by common academic interest and seek to develop collaborations and exchanges in fields of shared interest and expertise. The activities undertaken pursuant to this Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) are based on a spirit of cooperation and reciprocity that is intended to be of mutual benefit to both parties.

1. Purpose

This MOA serves as written understanding of agreed upon principles between Samarkand University and the Department of Early Childhood Education of Dongguk University concerning a set of general academic objectives.

This is a non-binding agreement and is intended to clarify the nature and extent of the complementary activities that might be undertaken for the mutual benefit of the two parties. Each institution will be responsible for managing its own costs.

Commitments of specific institutional resources, personnel, space, facilities, or any other academic or intellectual activities that may be contemplated hereunder but are beyond the scope of this MOA.

To the extent that the implementation of any agreed upon activity requires a commitment of resources, personnel, credit-bearing coursework, or intellectual property, a supplement agreement must be negotiated and approved by the two parties before work on any of the projects can commence.

2. Objectives, Scope, and Major Activities

Both institutions agree to encourage the development of the following types of activities:

- Visits and informal exchange of faculty, scholars and administrators in specific areas of education, research and outreach.
- Cooperation in undergraduate as well as graduate education and training.
- Organization of joint conferences, symposia, or other scientific meetings on subject of mutual interest.
- Exchange of academic information and materials.
- Development of avenues for undergraduate and graduate student exchange during the academic year or summer terms.
- Exploration possibilities for developing joint research programs and collaborations.

- Other exchange and cooperation programs to which parties agree.

3. Responsibilities of the Parties

The two parties recognize that the implementation of any agreed upon activity will depend upon the interests and expertise of the individuals involved and the availability of financial resources, space and other resources. Accordingly, the implementation of any exchange and cooperative program based on this MOA shall be separately negotiated and determined between the two institutions. It is further expected that both parties will be compliant with all applicable laws and regulations and University policies.

4. Duration and Option to Amend, Extend or Terminate

This MOA will become effective when signed by both parties. The agreement will remain in effect for five (5) years from the signature date, below, and may be renewed or amended by mutual agreement of the parties. The parties agree to periodically review the activities undertaken and the progress made and to consult concerning amendments, renewal or termination of this MOA. Either party may terminate this MOA at any time by providing written notice of such termination to the other party no less than six (6) months prior to the date of termination. Such notice of termination will not interfere with cooperative programs already underway as of the date of termination. Such programs will be allowed to continue until their conclusion. The institutions will confer concerning the renewal of this agreement six (6) months Prior to its expiration.

5. General Terms

This MOA is not intended to create, and does not create any right, benefit, or trust responsibility, substantive or procedural, enforceable by law or equity, by either party, its officers, employees, or agents against the other party, its officers, employees, or agents.

Nothing in this MOA obligates either party to commit or transfer any funds, assets, or other resources in support of projects or activities developed by the two parties.

Neither party will use the name of the other, either expressly or by implication, in any publicity, solicitation or advertisement without the express written approval of the other party to this MOA.


The differing viewpoints and interpretations of this agreement shall be settled amicably by mutual consultation or negotiation.

Samarkand University designates Vice-Rector and Department of Early Childhood Education of Dongguk University, Gyeongju designates Chair at Dept. of Early Childhood Education as their respective officers responsible for the full implementation of any program or activity created under this agreement.

This MOA is prepared in English and two (2) original copies of this MOA are produced for signature. This MOA shall enter into force on the date of the signing by qualified representatives of both institutions.


