

**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
ON
ACADEMIC AND RESEARCH COOPERATION
BETWEEN
PHILOLOGY AND TEACHING LANGUAGES: UZBEK LANGUAGE
DEPARTMENT SAMARKAND STATE UNIVERSITY
(UZBEKISTAN)
AND
INSTITUTE FOR EURASIAN TURKIC STUDIES
DONGDUK WOMEN'S UNIVERSITY
(KOREA)**

Philology and teaching languages: Uzbek language department, Samarkand State University, Uzbekistan and Institute for Eurasian Turkic Studies, Dongduk Women's University, Korea in recognition of their common interest in promoting mutual cooperation in the area of education, culture and research, have set forth the following Memorandum of Understanding (MoU):

Article I: Purpose

The purpose of this MoU is to develop academic and research cooperation on the basis of equality and reciprocity and to promote a sustainable partnership and mutual understanding between the two organizations.

Article II: Scope of Cooperation

Both sides undertake to promote and develop academic cooperation as follows:

1. Exchange faculty academic staff and student;
2. Exchange of educational research materials, published research articles, textbooks and etc..
3. To prepare joint research projects and organize (online) seminars training for academic and administrative staff and doctorate (PhD) students of the faculty in agreed study filed;
4. To publish research articles in the institutional Journals of both parties;
5. To organize International conferences, symposiums and seminar-tranings in chosen area.

Article III: Intellectual Property Rights and Publication

1. Both sides will share all data and research findings, patent rights, copyrights, and other intellectual property rights to any discoveries, inventions and products resulting from this MOU.
2. Both sides must provide a written approval for the utilization and publication of the data and research findings.
3. Detailed management of the Intellectual Property Rights and Publication shall be defined in the Agreement for Implementation of each activity.

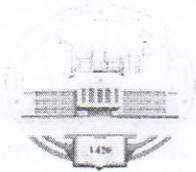
Article IV: Settlement of Differences

Differing view points and interpretations of this MoU shall be settled amicably by mutual consultation or negotiation.

Article V: Amendments, Duration and Termination

1. Amendments to this MoU can only be written by mutual consent of the two sides.
2. This MoU shall be in effect from the date of its signing and be valid for the duration of five (5) years from that date, and will be automatically renewed for the next five (5) years, unless terminated or replaced with a new MoU.
3. This MoU may be terminated by either party by written notice at least six (6) months in advance. Such termination or notice thereof shall not affect the completion of existing activities or programs as agreed upon in any Agreement for Implementation.

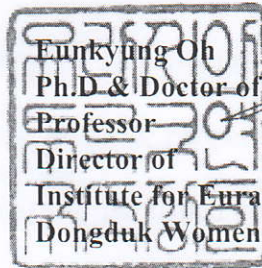
