**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
ON ACADEMIC CO-OPERATION
BETWEEN
UNIVERSITY OF MARBURG (GERMANY)
AND
SAMARKAND STATE UNIVERSITY NAMED AFTER SHAROF
RASHIDOV (UZBEKISTAN)**

1. University of Marburg and Samarkand State University named after Sharof Rashidov have concluded this Memorandum of Agreement in recognition of the mutual benefits accruing to their academic communities from the establishment of strong international links.
2. The purpose of this Memorandum is to promote friendly relations through the development of academic collaboration between the two universities.
3. The two universities agree to promote and develop their co-operation by the following means:
 - a. Student mobility and visiting scholar programs;
 - b. Academic programs collaborations;
 - c. Joint publication and research activities;
 - d. Exchange of academic materials and other information;
 - e. Scholarly activities such as courses, seminars, trainings, conferences, and symposiums organized by either of the Parties;
 - f. Facilitating scientific internships for young scientists and researchers;
 - g. Organizing consultative meeting to foster collaboration in securing grants from International bodies;
 - h. Assisting and cooperating in the initiation and realization of joint projects;
 - i. The Parties may mutually agree upon other activities and programs.

4. Members of staff of both universities will be encouraged to consult with each other and to develop specific plans for collaboration in any of the ways mentioned in Article 3 above.
5. Recognizing that the implementation of any form of academic collaboration depends on the availability of financial support, both universities will make their best efforts to support the activities proposed in the Memorandum.
6. This Memorandum will become effective from the date when representatives of both universities shall have affixed their signatures to it, and shall initially be valid for a period of five years. The Memorandum may be extended beyond this period if the representatives of both universities begin a discussion about it at least three months before the end of the first period.
7. The Memorandum may be revised or amended by mutual agreement during its period of validity. It may also be terminated within this period by either party by giving at least six months' written notice to the other party.
