



Policy To Reducing Plastic Waste

Samarkand State University adopted a policy to regulate the use of plastic at university-owned buildings and satellite campuses. This policy outlines the guidelines and practices aimed at minimizing plastic use, promoting recycling, and encouraging alternatives.

This policy aimed to reduce single-use plastics, promote environmentally friendly materials, recycle and manage waste, awareness campaigns, partnerships with stakeholders, and incentives.

Samarkand State University enforces a comprehensive plastic ban across its campus to reduce environmental risks associated with plastic use. A central committee has been established to oversee compliance with the ban, and banners displaying the message “Say No to Plastics” are prominently placed throughout university grounds to promote awareness.

The policy to reduce plastic usage is widely distributed and accessible at all university offices, buildings, bookstores, canteens, and cafés to ensure broad dissemination. Additionally, it is available on the university's website.

To support and strengthen the implementation of this policy, the university actively promotes various initiatives such as awareness campaigns, workshops, events, and debates that encourage students to avoid single-use plastics.
